- Do not operate charger with damaged cigarette lighter connector - replace it immediately.
- 7. Do not operate charger if it has received a sharp blow, been dropped, or otherwise damaged in any way; take it to a qualified service person.
- 8. Do not disassemble charger.
- To reduce risk of electric shock, unplug charger before attempting any maintenance or cleaning.
- 10. Connect the charger to a 12 V or 24 V electrical system only. Some vehicles operate on 36 V electrical systems. Refer to vehicle operator's manual.
- 11. Using the charger for extended periods of time can completely discharge your vehicle's battery. Unplug the charger whenever the engine is switched off for extended periods of time. The power does not turn off after switching off the engine in some vehicles. If the charger is left connected, your vehicle's battery may become discharged.


SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

Intended Use

- This charger is intended for charging cell phones, tablets, cameras and similar IT equipment. Do not use it to charge devices with a total power requirement of more than 45W per each charging socket.
- This charger is intended for private use only. It is not intended for commercial use.
- This charger is intended to be used in dry indoor areas only.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

NOTICE

It is recommended to use the charger only after starting the vehicle's engine to avoid discharging of the vehicle's battery.

• Insert the charger into the cigarette lighter receptacle. The power indicator 3 lights up.



- Connect an external device(s) to the charger using an USB type-A charging cable (not provided).
- After use, disconnect the USB-A cable from the charging socket 1 and unplug the charging from the cigarette lighter receptacle.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause
The power indicator 3 does not light	The cigarette lighter receptacle is not in the power supply mode. Refer to the operating instructions of your vehicle to enter the power supply mode.
up.	Ensure the charger is connected to the 12 V or 24 V electrical system.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning

- Unplug the charger before cleaning.
- During cleaning do not immerse the charger in water or other liquids. Never hold the charger under running water.
- To clean the charger, wipe with a soft, slightly moist cloth.
- Never use corrosive detergents, wire brushes, abrasive scourers, metal or sharp utensils to clean the charger.

Storage

Store the charger in its original packaging in a dry area. Keep away from children and pets.
